- * The price must include tax and be an even dollar amount (\$3, \$18, \$50 etc)
- * You are responsible for reporting your own income from this booth.

- * **You must still pre-register your artwork by August 27.**
- * **Payment from sales will be made at the September 16th meeting**

Volunteer time is required of all artists placing work in the booth. Please mark on the volunteer postcard, your preference for volunteering at Art in the Park. The postcard will be included with the Summer Newsletter, or you may contact Jan Pflieger at 675-7748 or jansriver@verizon.net with your preference for volunteering. If it is impossible to give 2 hours of your time for Art in the Park and/or the Member Booth, a fee of \$10.00 will be required at the time of registration.

We only have Friday to set up the booth and hang all the artwork, therefore your artwork must arrive at the park between **7 am and 3 pm on Friday, Sept. 10th**.

If you cannot arrive by 3 pm, please send your work with another artist or call Lynn Block, 443.2151 or Gail Jaeger, 355.0282 to make other arrangements.

Help is needed: Friday 7 am – 6 pm Saturday 8-5 Sunday 8-6

A schedule is posted in the booth so you know who is coming to replace you.

Emergency/help cell phone numbers are also listed.

Instructions on how to take payments etc. are in the booth.

Volunteer meeting is planned for Thurs. Aug .26 at 6 pm at the Trail's End Restaurant

Place info tags on back/bottom of each piece. Limit number of pieces to:

Four framed originals (mini's to as large as 16x20 framed) **OR**

Four, 3-D pieces (pottery, sculpture, and carving) **plus**

10 prints, matted & in clear bags (print rack and card rack is provided) **and up to**

25 art or photo cards (5x7) in clear bags. List total number of cards – they do not have to be registered individually, but must have small label w/your initials & price

If too many large pieces are received to hang at once, they will be stored under the tables and rotated in. (Getting too many pieces has not been a problem in the past.)

Please make sure items have secure, hanging wires on the back. No sawtooth hangers – they do not work w/our racks.
