**Watercolor & Masa Paper Workshop** with Jan Pflieger and Lee Ann Schulz

Japanese masa paper is collaged to the watercolor paper, crushing the fibers, creating a wonderful abstract result.

**9:30AM ARRIVAL AND SET UP TIME**

**10:00AM-3:00 PM CLASS TIME** with time to finish and pack up until 4 pm

There will be a break for lunch, to let the work dry when collaged to watercolor paper.

Cost: **\$15 FOR WVAA MEMBERS AND \$30 FOR NON-MEMBERS** (this is the opportune time to join the WVAA and get classes for \$15...we promise an exciting array in 2017 to pick from). **Payment will be made at the class.**

**About the workshop:**

Cost of the workshop will include the following supplies: 2 pieces of the Masa paper for each participant. The WVAA will provide sponge brushes and school glue. (Estimated value \$4-5 each person- cost is included in the cost of the class... just letting you know this is a really good deal for a a class/workshop!.)

Additional Masa Paper will be available for purchase at the workshop for cost, if you really like the technique and want to do more after the class. Participants should plan to bring the rest of their own supplies. This is a good opportunity to use up some of your "bad" watercolor paper, as it covered by the Masa paper and does not need to be the good stuff....

**Supply list:**

Drawing paper (pad), cheap watercolor paper, watercolors, water containers, paper towels or rags....brushes, **gator-board or regular painted watercolor board to staple your work to to dry**, stapler filled with staples, and **whatever else you might usually take to a watercolor class**. Photos, drawings, or an idea of subject matter you would like to paint.

**To Prep for the class:**

Consider your subject and composition. You can work out your composition on index paper and do a value study in advance, or at the class. It is good to have not everyone at the same place in the class.. as it flows well as per stations and space. You can work at your own pace.
